The conference also featured a graduate school fair where recruiters and advisers from graduate and professional schools provided information and career counseling for all attendees. ## Pairings Set for NSU Teams at MEAC Tournament

Pairings are set for the 2012 MEAC Basketball Tournament, which runs March 5-10 at the Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum in Winston-Salem, N.C. The NSU women's basketball team earned the No. 9 seed—its best since 2004-05—and will play a first-round game against No. 8 Bethune-Cookman at 11 a.m. on Monday. The NSU men earned the No. 2 seed, their best regular-season finish ever, and earned a first-round bye. The Spartans will play an 8 p.m. quarterfinal game on Wednesday night against the winner of the first-round game between No. 7 North Carolina A & T and No. 10 Howard.
